Peaceful uses of nuclear technology make significant contributions to the global challenges of our time, especially in the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.

The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), working in partnership with the industry, has striven to maximize the contribution of peaceful uses of nuclear technology towards the achievement of its Member States' development objectives.

Co-organized by the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA) and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), this event seeks to foster dialogue about questions such as: What role can the NPT and its review cycle play in expanding the contribution of industry to sustainable development through the peaceful uses of nuclear technology?
